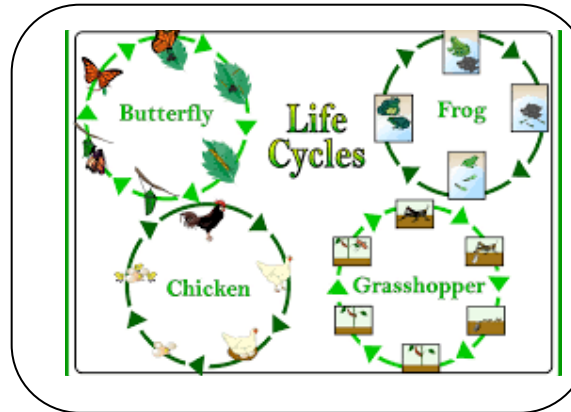


Key Questions
