The homework grid allows you to **choose** which homework you will do each week and hand in to your teacher.

There are various tasks shown below and we ask that you do **5 as a minimum** up to half term, and for those who like a challenge you can complete all of the tasks.

NB: Phonics and reading should be a daily 10 minute task - your efforts at home are really paying off!

<p>Key Skills 10 mins daily reading (this can include sharing a story with you).</p>	<p align="center"> Daily Phonics / spelling challenges</p> <p>Practice reading the tricky words and the sounds in your sound sacks. When you're confident with them, use them to make cvc, cvcc and ccvc words (consonant/vowel/consonant e.g. cat, pit, consonant/vowel/consonant/consonant e.g. went, sand and consonant/consonant/vowel/consonant e.g. flag, drip).</p> <p>Learn to read your tricky words. When you recognise them, you can learn to spell them.</p>

Can you draw a picture; chat to your grown up (parents you can write their thoughts on Tapestry) or get a grown up to video your ideas and share it on Tapestry?</p>	<p>Writing Can you have a go at writing your name? We are practising in school too! You can start by mastering the first letter and then add to it. If you can already write your name have a go at writing family names (Mummy, daddy, siblings).</p>	<p>Science Can you make a rocket that really flies! Some ideas are: a balloon rocket, a paper plane rocket or a baking soda and vinegar rocket. Take a video and share it on Tapestry to demonstrate it to us. (Parents, we love seeing the epic fails as much as the successful flights!)</p>
	<p>Calculate 1 alien have 3 eyes. Can you calculate how many eyes 2 aliens would have? You can use real objects to help you count. Can you draw a picture to prove it?</p> 	<p>Design Can you design a colourful new pair of underpants for those aliens that love underpants?</p> 	<p>Literacy Can you take a picture of your favourite book and tell TeamGB why you like it.
