


There are various tasks shown below and we ask that you do **5 as a minimum** up to half term, and for those who like a challenge you can complete more of the tasks.

<p>Key Skills</p>	<p align="center">Daily Phonics / spelling challenges</p> <p> Phonics and reading should be a daily 10 minute task - your efforts at home are really paying off!</p> <p>Practice your new digraphs and trigraphs. When you're confident with them, use them to make cvc, words (consonant/vowel/consonant e.g. ship, sheep, queen, high, chop, goat, moon, food, coin)</p> <p>Can you learn to read your tricky words? When you recognise them, have a go at learning to spell them.</p>

	<p>Calculate Can you have a go at solving some 1 more and 1 less maths problems? Here are some examples of word problem you can adapt. <i>There are 7 astronauts in the rocket getting ready to launch into space. 1 more astronaut climbs aboard. How many astronauts are in the rocket now?</i> <i>There are 5 aliens in a flying saucer. 1 alien flies away. How many aliens are left?</i></p>	<p>Writing Can you practice forming your curly letters correctly? c o a d g q s e f You can use pens and paper or your finger to write in shaving foam in the bath, flour in the kitchen, sand at the beach. Take pictures and share them on Tapestry - we love to see how well you're doing.</p>	<p>Science Can you make a rocket that really flies? Some ideas are: a balloon rocket, a bicarbonate of soda and vinegar rocket.
