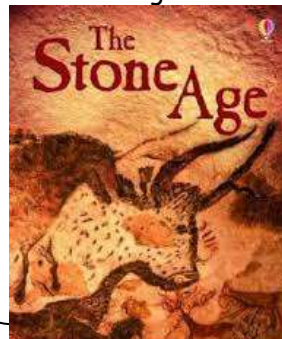
Values

Key Learning – Science Forces and Magnets

- Identify forces as push and pulls
- Describe friction as a force that slows things down.
- Feel the pulling force of a magnet
- Sort materials according to whether they are magnetic or not.
- Participate in an investigation to show magnet strength.
- Make a prediction and form a conclusion from their investigation.
- Identify the different poles on a bar magnet.
