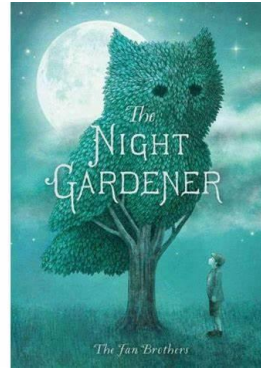


Key Questions
