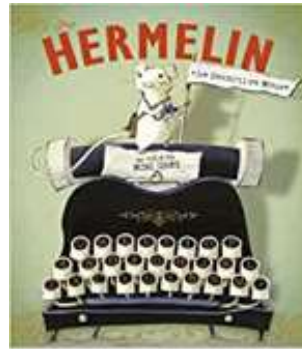

Values

Science - Sound

- I can identify how sounds are made associating some of them with something vibrating.
- I can recognise that vibrations from sound travel through a medium to the ear.
- I can find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produce it.
- I can find patterns between the volume of the sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it.
- I can recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases

Maths

- I can recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths
- I can find the effect of dividing a one or two digit number by 10 and 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones tenths and hundredths
- I can round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number
- I can solve simple measure and money
