I know and can name and locate the most densely populated towns on the Isle of Wight

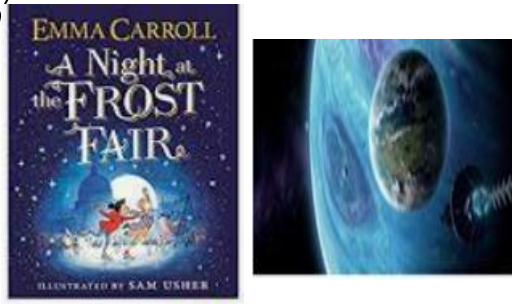
I know and can describe the weather patterns in my local area (rainfall, temperature, wind speed, cloud cover etc)
