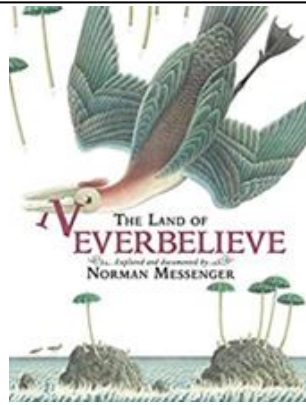


Key Questions
