

## THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION

Desired outcomes by July 2024

What will we see:

- ✓ Children in EYFS/KS1 learn to read well so that children in KS2 read well to learn and for pleasure
- ✓ Children in EYFS/KS1 learn to write well so that children in KS2 write accurately, fluently and at length across the curriculum.
- ✓ Children will have improved fluency, automaticity and accuracy with number across the school.
- ✓ All children will be accessing a broad and balanced curriculum with children demonstrating confidence in all subjects.
- ✓ All teachers have good subject knowledge to competently and confidently deliver the Computing curriculum resulting in high quality outcomes.
- ✓ Focused attention on vulnerable children in terms of the whole child – reaching out to the right kids in the right time in the right way has resulted in accelerated progress. (FSM, lowest 20%, SEND, PP, LAC, GDS)



## BEHAVIOUR & ATTITUDES

Desired outcomes by July 2024

What will we see:

- ✓ Further developed and enhanced trauma informed culture in school (staff, environment etc.)
- ✓ An effective attendance strategy is in place, resulting in no persistent absentees.
- ✓ Children know and have access to systems that 'Keep our friends safe' and trust that they are effective.

- ✓ School promotes equality of opportunity and diversity effectively and ensures that pupils show respect for the protected characteristics.
